



Instructions for Tent Rental

The following are some instructions/guidelines that you the customer will need to do to ensure a safe, quick and efficient tent installation. If you have any questions, please feel free to call 419.268.1800.

- Tent install area –
 - Please make sure the area where the tent is going to be installed is free of any obstruction. Please have the grassed mowed before our arrival, and also have any dog droppings picked up.
- Underground Utilities –
 - By law it is Reliable Tent Rental's responsibility to call OUPS/811 to have all underground utilities marked. Privately installed lines will not be marked by OUPS/811.
- Private Underground lines -
 - The renter is responsible for marking all privately installed underground utilities or items that OUPS/811 will not mark. Reliable Tents stake are 42" in length.
 - Examples – sprinkler lines, water lines, electric lines, invisible dog fence, private sewer lines such as septic or finger system and/or any other underground utilities.
- Asphalt Installation –
 - Reliable Tent will install tents on asphalt with stakes that are 42" in length. The holes can be patched with a plug or filled per the customer's request for an additional fee.
- Tent area requirements –
 - If you're renting a 20x20 tent, Reliable Tent will need an additional 5' to 10' around the perimeter of the tent for stake lines.
- Landscaping –
 - Reliable Tent will install the tent pretty much wherever you like. Some tent rentals close to a garage will also be close to landscaping/gardens. Reliable Tent crews will do everything to avoid damage to flowers/shrubbery but they must also have room to make sure the tent is properly anchored. Please keep this in mind prior to tent install.
- Additional Charges – additional charges may occur for the following...
 - Setup/deliveries done outside normal business hours
 - Weighting of tent if staking is not possible (customer must provide water for barrels)
 - Additional delivery fees for items added after Reliable Tent crew is onsite
